Recommending Teachers are encouraged to attend.

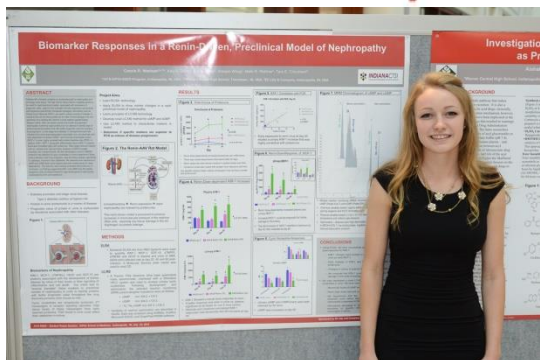

Directions to the IT Building, IUPUI Campus, corner of Michigan and West Street.

I-65

From the north: Take Exit 114 and follow West Street (Martin Luther King Jr. Street) south to Michigan Street and turn west (right).

From the south: Turn onto I-70 West from I-65. Take Exit 79A and follow West Street (Martin Luther King Jr. Street) north to Michigan Street and turn west (left).

I-70

From the west: Take exit 79A and follow West Street (Martin Luther King Jr. Street) north to Michigan Street and turn west (left).

From the east: Turn onto I-65 North from I-70 (exit from far left lane). Take Exit 114 to West Street (Martin Luther King Jr. Street) then south to Michigan Street and turn west (right).

From Michigan Street . . .

Continue west on Michigan into the IUPUI Campus. As soon as you pass West Street, the IT Building is on the left. However, you must continue to the next corner with Blackford and make a right to go into the Gateway Parking Garage.

Please Park in the Gateway Parking Garage*. Continue on Michigan to the next traffic signal at Blackford Street. Make a right and then another right into the Gateway Parking Garage structure. Please keep the parking ticket; you will need it to exit.

**Parking cost: Project SEED usually will have validation cards to cover parking expenses for all program guests. It is placed in the same slot as the ticket you received to enter the garage. Sometimes these cards do not work properly so we ask guests to please bring \$5-8 dollars to cover parking costs if needed. Thank you!*
