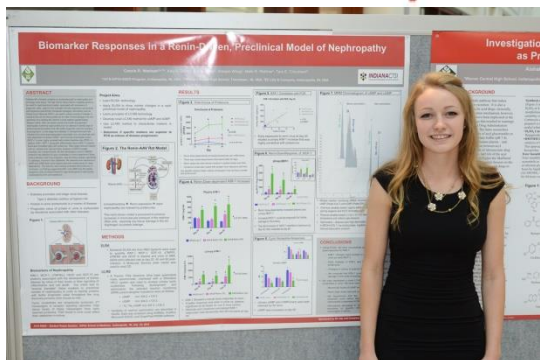

**\*Location and Parking:** The IUPUI Campus Center is located at 420 North University Boulevard, Indianapolis, IN 46202.

Because of construction on Michigan Avenue, please enter the IUPUI campus on New York Avenue coming from West Street, go one block past University Blvd and turn right on Patterson Street. Go through the open parking lots, stop and cross Vermont Street into the Vermont Street parking garage Visitor section. Keep the white parking card to get out of the lot. At the meeting, you will receive a yellow validation card that you can use as payment. The Campus Center is the building next door at the corner of Vermont Street and University Boulevard. Proceed to the Theater Auditorium on the Basement Level.
